## JUNE–JULY TRANSLATION FORECASTS

Translation deadlines:



### Average per week

- Overall **very high** workload
- 1910 pages per week



### Peaks in workload

**Very high** workload throughout the period



### Possible bottlenecks

- **Summer school holidays:** July–August
- **Office-closing days:** 23 June (Luxembourg)

Translation submission:

For the next six weeks, the forecast chart indicates a **very high level of submissions**, averaging around **1900 pages per week**.

Demand from committees is expected to remain consistently high over this period, with a peak during the July pre-session week, when almost 2700 pages are expected.
